A case of COVID-19 has been diagnosed in an individual at Churchill Community High School in La Ronge. We are working closely with Public Health staff to ensure necessary measures are in place to protect all staff and students.

Public Health will be contacting parents/guardians of students and any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in **close contact** with the case and providing direction. This means if you are not contacted by Public Health, your child can continue to attend school. To protect the privacy of individuals, we are not able to share or discuss further details. **Churchill Community High School will resume regular classes on Tuesday, October 27, 2020.**

We remind everyone entering schools to [monitor](#) for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

Deep cleaning of the affected areas will be complete by days end, Monday, October 26<sup>th</sup>. The safety protocols our school has put in place are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Mask requirements, proper hand hygiene, physical distancing when possible, and cohorting classes are all measures our school has implemented to help protect students and staff members. These measures will significantly reduce the possible spread of the virus.
