Dear Parents/Guardians,

On the afternoon of December 21, 2020, Northern Lights School Division became aware of one individual who has been confirmed COVID-19 positive at Churchill Community High School.

We have been advised that Public Health has completed the initial part of the case and contact investigation related to the school setting.

Following a detailed risk assessment by the Medical Health Officer all close contacts (high risk) have been identified and will be provided with the appropriate direction from Public Health regarding isolation, testing and follow up.

If you do not hear from them directly, that means your child has not been assessed to be a close contact and can continue to attend school as per their regular schedule.

At this point, there is no evidence of COVID-19 transmission within the school setting.

Under the direction of the Medical Health Officer, the affected part of Churchill School will undergo deep cleaning and disinfection as per the recommended protocol, through the guidance provided by the Saskatchewan Health Authority's (SHA) Public Health Inspectors.

This includes contingency plans, in the event that public health recommends an alternate level of instruction at any time during the pandemic event.
